

International Institute of Business Analysis (IIBA®) Endorsed Education Provider (EEP™)

and provides answers to the most frequently asked questions*

What is the IIBA®?

The International Institute of Business Analysis (IIBA®) is an independent non-profit professional association that helps individuals working in the field of business analysis develop their skills and further their careers.

Credited with creating the *Business Analysis Body of Knowledge® (BABOK®)*, the IIBA® has become the leading association in the field of business analysis.

The IIBA® has awarded Learning Tree International EEP status, which entitles Learning Tree to be listed on the IIBA®'s online registry as a provider of approved content.

What does the EEP designation mean?

Members of the Endorsed Education Provider (EEP) program consist of education providers offering business analysis courses that align with the IIBA® *Business Analysis Body of Knowledge® (BABOK®)*.

Courses are submitted to IIBA® for thorough review and, once approved, are listed on the IIBA® Web site as endorsed by IIBA®. Further, those courses approved by the IIBA® can award Continuing Development Units (CDUs) to those who complete the course.

As an EEP, Learning Tree is committed to enhancing the ongoing professional development of IIBA® members, business analysts and those interested in learning more about the field.

What is the BABOK®?

The *BABOK®* is a collection of knowledge for professional business analysts. The *BABOK®* reflects what is current generally accepted practice and describes business analysis areas of knowledge, their associated activities and tasks, and the skills necessary to be effective in their execution. Learning Tree courses align with *BABOK®* v2.0.

What is the CBAP® certification?

The Certified Business Analysis Professional™ (CBAP®) is a formal certification offered by the IIBA® for business analysis professionals with extensive business analysis experience. A CBAP® is a recognised expert in identifying the business needs of an organisation in order to determine business solutions. The certification is based on the best practices contained within the *BABOK®*. The CBAP® credential recognises the experience and skills required to effectively perform business analysis activities within an organisation.

What is the CCBA™?

The Certification of Competency in Business Analysis™ (CCBA™) exam is a formal certification developed by the IIBA® to validate the knowledge and skills of business analysis professionals with at least two and a half years of experience. The CCBA™ credential recognises a strong understanding of all six knowledge areas of the *BABOK® Guide*, with proven proficiency in at least two.

Is there a Learning Tree course that helps me prepare for the CCBA?

Yes. Course 3503, *Preparing for the IIBA® CCBA™ Certification Exam*, provides the knowledge and skills to prepare for the CCBA™ certification exam. Demonstrations and practice quizzes reinforce the concepts and provide the framework for a personalised study plan for exam success.

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What is required in order to take the CCBA™ exam?

Anyone interested in taking the exam must first apply for certification and then successfully complete the initial screening process. Once qualified, those wishing to take the exam may register for an exam date listed on their application.

Certification requirements can be found in the *CCBA™ Handbook*. In general, certification requirements include education, work experience, expertise in the *BABOK®* knowledge areas, professional development and references.

Are there requirements for maintaining the CBAP® or CCBA™ certifications?

Those holding the CBAP® or CCBA™ certifications are required to meet continuing proficiency requirements in order to maintain their designations. CBAP®s are required to report at least 60 continuing development units (CDUs). For both certifications, certification holders must submit a renewal fee every three years.
